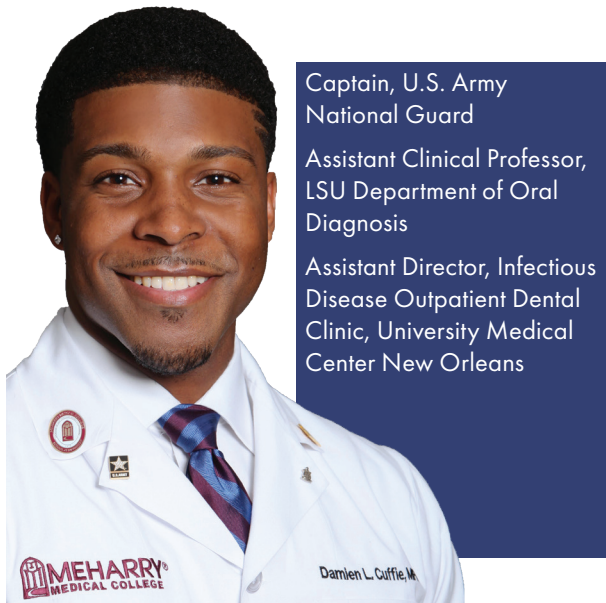


# BEYOND MEHARRY
