



WHO CAN SUBMIT EVENT REQUESTS IN CG?






Only members with the status of "Officer", within their organization, are able to submit event requests in Campus Groups (CG).

*organizations can have multiple Officers.






Once you log into CG, pull up the Pre-Alumni Association Group Page. The dashboard page will pop up.

Click on the "Events" Tab!





At the top right of your screen, there will be a green "Create Event" tab.






Once you begin to fill out the form you will scroll through each section until completion.


When will my event get approved???



The Office of Student Life will receive the notification that your request was submitted. Then the process of approval will be begin.


PROCESS OF EVENT APPROVAL







EVENT STATUS










ONCE APPROVED YOU MAY BEGIN PROMOTING
