



STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

IMMUNIZATION AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Prior to registration, all students entering Meharry Medical College are required to submit official documentation verifying compliance with institutional immunization and health requirements.

All records must be official documents. Hard copies of all required quantitative serologic titer results must be provided where applicable. Submitted records will be reviewed by Student Health Services to determine compliance.

Required Immunizations and Quantitative Serologic Titers

- **Hepatitis B:** Documentation of a complete three-dose vaccination series and a quantitative Hepatitis B surface antibody titer.
- **MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella):** Documentation of two doses of MMR vaccine or quantitative serologic titers confirming immunity.
- **Varicella (Chickenpox):** Documentation of two doses of varicella vaccine, or quantitative serologic titers, or documented history of disease.
- **Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis):** Documentation of a Tdap vaccine administered within the past 10 years.
- **Polio:** Documentation of completed polio immunization.
- **Meningococcal ACWY:** One dose administered after age 16 is required only for students living on campus.
- **COVID-19:** Documentation of completion of a two-dose primary vaccination series.
- **Influenza:** one dose annually each fall is required.
- **Tuberculosis Screening:** Documentation of one of the following is required: a PPD test, an IGRA test, or a previous positive PPD with proof of completed treatment and a chest X-ray report. All documentation must be dated within the past 6 months.

Physical Examination Requirement

All incoming students must submit a completed Health Surveillance/Physical Examination form, signed by a licensed healthcare provider. The physical examination must have been performed within the last 12 months prior to registration.

Compliance and Registration

An immunization hold will remain on the student's account until all required documentation has been received and verified as complete by Student Health Services.
